Current Use of Electronic Billing and Payment Transactions

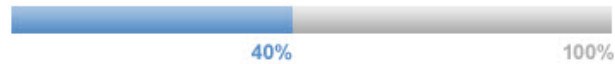
Current utilization of electronic transactions by type



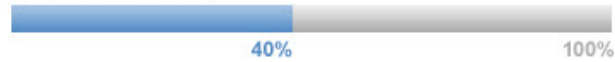

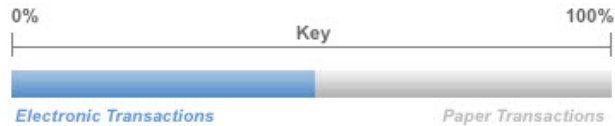

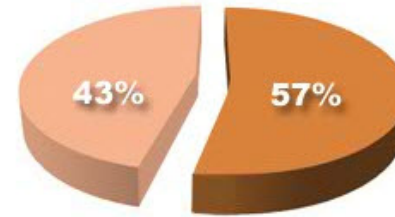

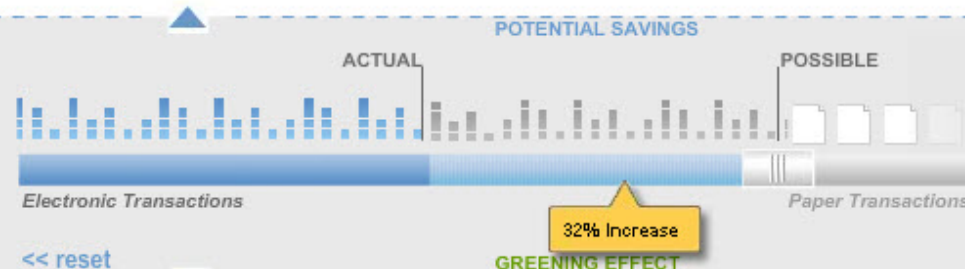
