Marianne Yeager – Executive Director, Healthway

Ms. Yeager serves as Executive Director for Healthway, Inc., a public-private collaborative leading efforts to advance secure, nationwide and interoperable exchange of health information, and operationally supporting the eHealth Exchange. She has more than 20 years of experience in the health information technology field. Prior to Healthway, Ms. Yeager worked for 5 years on ONC nationwide health information network initiatives and also helped launch and run the country's first EHR certification program in 2006.

John Rancourt, MPA – Public Health Analyst (ONC)

John Rancourt is a Public Health Analyst with the Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC) within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. He joined ONC in May 2011 as part of the Presidential Management Fellows Program. John received his Master's in Public Administration from American University in December 2010. During his studies, he was a Christine Mirzayan Science and Technology Policy Fellow at the Institute of Medicine and was a Health Care Analyst Graduate Student Intern at the Government Accountability Office. During his career in health policy, he has worked on Capitol Hill, on a political campaign, as a patient advocate, and as a journalist. John went to Georgetown University for his undergraduate studies, and is originally from Chicago. He lives with his wife, Anne, in Washington, D.C.

Matthew Rahn – Program Analyst, Office of Science and Technology (ONC)

Matthew has worked at the Office of the National Coordinator for Health IT (ONC) as a Program Analyst in the Office of Science and Technology since 2011, managing various projects and initiatives around implementation of health information exchange including provider directories, Direct Project, Direct Certificate discovery and SOAP transport and security standards. Prior to joining ONC, Matt worked at Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) focusing on how the Affordable Care Act impacted HRSA's mission to reach the underserved. Matt graduated from University of Arizona in 2006 with a B.S. in Health Sciences, and originally hails from southern Oregon. He is an avid Bay Area sports fan and lives in Washington DC.
