

Primary Care: Rethinking Model With Tele-Well Visits

- Hybrid CareConnect visit and outpatient tent immunization visit.
- Despite a 36.3% decrease in well child visits, there was only an 18.8% decrease in the number of immunizations given (45,764 in 2020 vs 56,348 in 2019)
- Visits were performed either before, the same day, or after.





Building Sustainable Workflows

- Appropriate modality building decision tree workflows for each subspecialty, accessible by all schedulers
- Integrated translation services
- Integrated tele-product that launches scheduled video visits from Epic, Haiku or Canto – no separate app or login.
- Patients can join through the Nemours app OR can receive invitation text or email separately
- Providers can leverage screen sharing functionality
- Handoff features that enable clinic staff/support workflows and multi-specialty visits.










Future of Telehealth at Children's Health

- Every bed in the health system is now telemedicine capable.




